DIRECTIONS

From North: Take I-91 South to exit 26. Turn right at end of ramp, then immediate left and follow Marsh Street to stop sign at Main Street. Turn left onto Main Street. The Keeney Memorial is the 3rd building on the left.

From South: Take I-91 North to exit 25/26. Bear right and take exit 26 to Old Wethersfield. Turn left at the end of ramp and follow the signs to Marsh Street. (You will go under the highway.) Follow Marsh Street to stop sign at Main Street. Turn left onto Main Street, the Keeney Memorial is the 3rd building on the left,

From East or West: Take I-84 to I-91 South. Take I-91 to exit 26 and follow the directions above.

There is a fountain in front of the building. Parking is in rear.
